Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,742
Single restaurant server	\$22,845 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$62
Teacher and office clerk family	\$51,112 and \$40,192 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$764
Single nurse with overtime	\$79,410 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,340
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,150 median local wage; 1 child	\$407
Electrician family	One earner at \$52,798 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$564
Plumber family	One earner at \$50,596 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$564
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,707 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$564
Police officer family		\$764

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$38,126 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	Tax increase of \$370
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$49,497 and \$30,150 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$764
