Single restaurant server	\$30,328 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	Tax increase of \$0
Teacher and office clerk family	\$59,319 and \$41,185 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$764
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,373 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,428
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,296 median local wage; 1 child	\$407
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,537 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$564
Plumber family	One earner at \$57,271 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$564
Construction worker family	One earner at \$45,394 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$564
