Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,462
Single restaurant server	\$35,003 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$337
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,739 and \$37,978 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$757
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,410 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,353
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,343 median local wage; 1 child	\$354
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,790 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$285
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,735 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$285
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,129 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$285
Police officer family	One earner at \$74,288 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$485

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,582 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$485
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,649 and \$35,343 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$638
