Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,462
Single restaurant server	\$35,380 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$380
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,412 and \$39,693 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$757
Single nurse with overtime	\$82,120 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,339
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,024 median local wage; 1 child	\$354
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,394 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$285
Plumber family	One earner at \$77,549 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$438
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,455 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$285
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,073 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$638

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,402 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$485
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,432 and \$36,024 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$638
