HOUSEHOLD EXAMPLE	ASSUMPTIONS	ANNUAL TAX RELIEF
Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,474
Single restaurant server	\$40,428 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$624
Teacher and office clerk family	\$68,530 and \$49,941 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$685
Single nurse with overtime	\$99,686 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,881
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,690 median local wage; 1 child	\$200
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,818 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$565
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,860 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$565
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,364 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$297
Police officer family	One earner at \$69,614 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$687

HOUSEHOLD EXAMPLE	ASSUMPTIONS	ANNUAL TAX RELIEF
<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$58,712 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$765
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$60,349 and \$37,690 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$685

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
