Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,499
Single restaurant server	\$24,882 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$74
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,278 and \$47,603 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$785
Single nurse with overtime	\$106,611 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,620
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,287 median local wage; 1 child	\$271
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,870 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$382
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,489 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$382
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,989 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$599
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,421 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$582

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$69,502 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$582
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$64,369 and \$34,287 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$785
