Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,499
Single restaurant server	\$26,324 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$74
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,639 and \$43,167 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$785
Single nurse with overtime	\$104,844 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,601
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,165 median local wage; 1 child	\$271
Electrician family	One earner at \$66,866 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$382
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,400 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$382
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,521 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$599
Police officer family	One earner at \$80,991 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$582

Firefighter family	One earner at \$62,317 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$582
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,091 and \$30,165 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$582
