Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,541
Single restaurant server	\$47,830 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$985
Teacher and office clerk family	\$90,761 and \$45,936 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,278
Single nurse with overtime	\$108,715 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,557
Single-parent home health aide	\$39,100 median local wage; 1 child	\$359
Electrician family	One earner at \$79,745 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$464
Plumber family	One earner at \$80,774 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$464
Construction worker family	One earner at \$59,381 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$364
Police officer family	One earner at \$95,795 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$664

Firefighter family	One earner at \$90,987 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$664
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,305 and \$39,100 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,278
