Single restaurant server	\$46,340 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$889
Teacher and office clerk family	\$97,126 and \$48,310 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,278
Single nurse with overtime	\$116,809 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,646
Single-parent home health aide	\$39,110 median local wage; 1 child	\$359
Electrician family	One earner at \$78,694 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$464
Plumber family	One earner at \$81,741 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$464
Construction worker family	One earner at \$63,661 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$503
Police officer family	One earner at \$108,888 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$1,278

Firefighter family	One earner at \$108,330 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$1,278
