Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,541
Single restaurant server	\$49,529 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,061
Teacher and office clerk family	\$80,488 and \$45,082 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,278
Single nurse with overtime	\$95,197 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,432
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,277 median local wage; 1 child	\$359
Electrician family	One earner at \$74,968 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$464
Plumber family	One earner at \$84,450 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$464
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,051 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$364
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,662 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$664

Firefighter family	One earner at \$75,287 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$664
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,708 and \$38,277 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,278
