Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,541
Single restaurant server	\$47,255 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$956
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,872 and \$42,660 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,278
Single nurse with overtime	\$96,210 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,443
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,056 median local wage; 1 child	\$359
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,390 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$464
Plumber family	One earner at \$69,376 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$503
Construction worker family	One earner at \$51,101 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$364
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,703 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$664

Firefighter family	One earner at \$85,290 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$664
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,250 and \$37,056 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$664
