Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,271
Single restaurant server	\$37,417 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$454
Teacher and office clerk family	\$67,357 and \$44,935 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$830
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,401 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,394
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,434 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,141 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,298 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,173 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,284 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510

Firefighter family	One earner at \$59,816 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,928 and \$32,434 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$510
