Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,271
Single restaurant server	\$38,328 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$502
Teacher and office clerk family	\$76,612 and \$46,523 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$830
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,954 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,400
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,131 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,023 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,476 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,775 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Police officer family	One earner at \$102,908 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510

Firefighter family	One earner at \$73,125 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,151 and \$32,131 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$510
