Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,271
Single restaurant server	\$36,799 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$414
Teacher and office clerk family	\$75,193 and \$45,365 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$830
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,232 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,392
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,911 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$68,071 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,806 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,636 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,751 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$64,233 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$58,850 and \$31,911 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$510
