Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,271
Single restaurant server	\$37,361 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$451
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,084 and \$44,720 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$510
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,194 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,124
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,932 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,885 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,235 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,754 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,749 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$55,753 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$60,725 and \$32,932 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$510
