Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,271
Single restaurant server	\$37,142 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$440
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,484 and \$43,807 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$830
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,873 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,098
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,557 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$74,922 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,871 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,043 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Police officer family	One earner at \$76,267 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510

Firefighter family	One earner at \$62,398 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,609 and \$31,557 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$510
