Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,271
Single restaurant server	\$37,458 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$456
Teacher and office clerk family	\$76,927 and \$44,593 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$830
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,334 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,115
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,735 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,157 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,506 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,749 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,119 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510

Firefighter family	One earner at \$58,419 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,771 and \$32,735 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$510
