Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,271
Single restaurant server	\$36,708 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$409
Teacher and office clerk family	\$75,523 and \$44,965 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$830
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,978 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,122
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,815 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$67,893 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,302 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Construction worker family	One earner at \$56,697 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,770 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,063 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$510
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,373 and \$31,815 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$510
