Single restaurant server	\$20,477 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$18
Teacher and office clerk family	\$49,668 and \$37,597 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$751
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,554 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,326
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,323 median local wage; 1 child	Tax increase of \$429
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,821 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$541
Plumber family	One earner at \$56,458 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$541
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,200 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$310
Police officer family		\$751
