Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,423
Single restaurant server	\$32,632 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$78
Teacher and office clerk family	\$69,669 and \$48,787 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$770
Single nurse with overtime	\$118,946 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,500
Single-parent home health aide	\$40,885 median local wage; 1 child	\$314
Electrician family	One earner at \$83,127 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$649
Plumber family	One earner at \$80,160 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$649
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,291 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$366
Police officer family	One earner at \$90,990 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$657

Firefighter family	One earner at \$77,493 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$832
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,805 and \$40,885 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$770
