Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,886
Single restaurant server	\$31,194 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$170
Teacher and office clerk family	\$78,545 and \$44,886 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$808
Single nurse with overtime	\$90,194 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,216
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,175 median local wage; 1 child	\$296
Electrician family	One earner at \$67,329 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Plumber family	One earner at \$68,616 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,910 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$708
Police officer family	One earner at \$88,897 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$658

Firefighter family	One earner at \$73,537 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$658
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,267 and \$30,175 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$808
