Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,886
Single restaurant server	\$30,132 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$114
Teacher and office clerk family	\$74,546 and \$44,625 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$808
Single nurse with overtime	\$88,072 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,193
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,977 median local wage; 1 child	\$296
Electrician family	One earner at \$71,438 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Plumber family	One earner at \$69,334 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,286 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$708
Police officer family	One earner at \$87,301 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$658

Firefighter family	One earner at \$65,350 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$658
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,170 and \$29,977 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$808
