Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,886
Single restaurant server	\$29,263 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	Tax increase of \$107
Teacher and office clerk family	\$73,052 and \$42,639 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$808
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,095 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,182
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,939 median local wage; 1 child	\$296
Electrician family	One earner at \$67,587 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,115 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Construction worker family	One earner at \$47,757 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$708
Police officer family		\$658

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
