Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,886
Single restaurant server	\$31,439 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$183
Teacher and office clerk family	\$77,142 and \$44,835 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$808
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,645 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,144
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,170 median local wage; 1 child	\$296
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,941 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Plumber family	One earner at \$68,103 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Construction worker family	One earner at \$51,091 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$708
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,805 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$658

Firefighter family	One earner at \$73,537 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$658
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,408 and \$30,170 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$658
