Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,886
Single restaurant server	\$31,415 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$181
Teacher and office clerk family	\$76,137 and \$44,741 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$808
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,284 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,140
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,895 median local wage; 1 child	\$296
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,861 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Plumber family	One earner at \$68,643 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$458
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,994 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$708
Police officer family	One earner at \$86,052 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$658

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$72,669 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$658
