Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,804
Single restaurant server	\$43,856 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$787
Teacher and office clerk family	\$90,988 and \$47,995 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$971
Single nurse with overtime	\$102,908 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,712
Single-parent home health aide	\$43,126 median local wage; 1 child	\$329
Electrician family	One earner at \$72,229 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$627
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,536 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$627
Construction worker family	One earner at \$60,009 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$627
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,559 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$694

Firefighter family	One earner at \$71,529 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$827
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,471 and \$43,126 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$694
