Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,804
Single restaurant server	\$37,669 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$467
Teacher and office clerk family	\$88,762 and \$48,016 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$971
Single nurse with overtime	\$100,088 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,345
Single-parent home health aide	\$40,686 median local wage; 1 child	\$329
Electrician family	One earner at \$73,413 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$627
Plumber family	One earner at \$77,480 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$627
Construction worker family	One earner at \$61,687 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$627
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,559 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$694

Firefighter family	One earner at \$70,263 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$827
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,379 and \$40,686 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$694
