Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,526
Single restaurant server	\$28,985 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	Tax increase of \$52
Teacher and office clerk family	\$59,458 and \$41,750 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,761
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,730 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,699
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,705 median local wage; 1 child	\$272
Electrician family	One earner at \$57,742 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$504
Plumber family	One earner at \$56,988 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$504
Construction worker family	One earner at \$45,283 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$348
Police officer family		\$590

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$39,110 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	Tax increase of \$244
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$53,551 and \$31,705 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$590
