Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,526
Single restaurant server	\$18,750 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$37
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,514 and \$35,769 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,761
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,241 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,664
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,323 median local wage; 1 child	\$138
Electrician family	One earner at \$51,174 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$348
Plumber family	One earner at \$50,751 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$348
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,818 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$551
Police officer family	One earner at \$61,033 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$704

Firefighter family	One earner at \$49,457 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$548
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$49,285 and \$28,323 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$590
