Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,485
Single restaurant server	\$29,248 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$6
Teacher and office clerk family	\$58,043 and \$38,266 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,404
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,361 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,116
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,626 median local wage; 1 child	\$291
Electrician family	One earner at \$60,936 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$566
Plumber family	One earner at \$59,433 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$566
Construction worker family	One earner at \$45,452 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$307
Police officer family	One earner at \$61,162 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$766

Firefighter family	One earner at \$48,695 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$507
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,250 and \$31,626 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$766
