Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,485
Single restaurant server	\$31,004 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$94
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,473 and \$40,502 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,404
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,456 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,139
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,877 median local wage; 1 child	\$291
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,817 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$566
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,666 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$566
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,686 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$307
Police officer family	One earner at \$67,701 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$766

Firefighter family	One earner at \$49,393 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$507
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,512 and \$33,877 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,404
