Single restaurant server	\$27,043 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$42
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,391 and \$34,892 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,183 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,409
Single-parent home health aide	\$24,127 median local wage; 1 child	\$69
Electrician family	One earner at \$51,208 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Plumber family	One earner at \$55,275 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Construction worker family	One earner at \$36,000 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	Tax increase of \$84
