Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,524
Single restaurant server	\$26,839 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$53
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,075 and \$33,809 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,780 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,405
Single-parent home health aide	\$22,968 median local wage; 1 child	\$69
Electrician family	One earner at \$47,954 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Plumber family	One earner at \$49,756 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Construction worker family	One earner at \$35,991 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	Tax increase of \$89
Police officer family		\$800

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$52,391 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$546
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$49,601 and \$22,968 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800

**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
