Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,524
Single restaurant server	\$27,454 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$20
Teacher and office clerk family	\$55,469 and \$37,286 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800
Single nurse with overtime	\$80,910 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,373
Single-parent home health aide	\$24,081 median local wage; 1 child	\$69
Electrician family	One earner at \$49,005 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Plumber family	One earner at \$49,892 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Construction worker family	One earner at \$37,523 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$287
Police officer family	One earner at \$78,681 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$800

HOUSEHOLD EXAMPLE	ASSUMPTIONS	ANNUAL TAX RELIEF
<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$79,223 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$800
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$50,531 and \$24,081 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
