Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,524
Single restaurant server	\$29,979 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,159 and \$39,306 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,669 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,470
Single-parent home health aide	\$25,737 median local wage; 1 child	\$43
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,203 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,256 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,884 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Police officer family	One earner at \$73,599 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$800

Firefighter family	One earner at \$64,508 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$546
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$51,063 and \$25,737 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800
