Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,524
Single restaurant server	\$30,096 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$8
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,191 and \$40,237 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800
Single nurse with overtime	\$90,960 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,484
Single-parent home health aide	\$25,982 median local wage; 1 child	Tax increase of \$28
Electrician family	One earner at \$55,535 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,318 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,290 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Police officer family		\$800

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$63,912 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$546
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$51,992 and \$25,982 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800

**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
