| Retired federal worker couple | Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income | \$1,524 |
| Single restaurant server | \$29,879 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children | Tax increase of \$6 |
| Teacher and office clerk family | \$62,198 and \$38,670 median local wages; married couple with 2 children | \$800 |
| Single nurse with overtime | \$89,274 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children | \$1,465 |
| Single-parent home health aide | \$25,437 median local wage; 1 child | \$76 |
| Electrician family | One earner at \$53,936 median local wage; married couple with 1 child | \$346 |
| Plumber family | One earner at \$59,920 median local wage; married couple with 1 child | \$346 |
| Construction worker family | One earner at \$38,683 median local wage; married couple with 1 child | \$346 |
