Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,524
Single restaurant server	\$23,419 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$54
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,762 and \$31,837 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800
Single nurse with overtime	\$78,880 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,351
Single-parent home health aide	\$23,876 median local wage; 1 child	\$69
Electrician family	One earner at \$46,183 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Plumber family	One earner at \$47,285 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$346
Construction worker family	One earner at \$32,816 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$87
Police officer family	One earner at \$59,221 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$546

Firefighter family	One earner at \$49,861 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$546
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$47,438 and \$23,876 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$800
