Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,518
Single restaurant server	\$31,172 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$86
Teacher and office clerk family	\$71,561 and \$45,080 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,078
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,288 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,127
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,769 median local wage; 1 child	\$274
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,689 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$340
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,145 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$340
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,302 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$340
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,135 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$1,078

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$57,987 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$540
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$63,340 and \$37,769 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,078
