Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,501
Single restaurant server	\$37,999 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$512
Teacher and office clerk family	\$68,054 and \$43,712 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$782
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,564 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,129
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,599 median local wage; 1 child	\$306
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,583 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Plumber family	One earner at \$62,820 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,872 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Police officer family	One earner at \$60,771 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$523

Firefighter family	One earner at \$59,320 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$523
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$50,466 and \$28,599 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$801
