Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,501
Single restaurant server	\$37,592 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$491
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,401 and \$45,904 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$782
Single nurse with overtime	\$92,295 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,225
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,027 median local wage; 1 child	\$324
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,986 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,762 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,036 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,283 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$523

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,274 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$523
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,627 and \$29,027 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$801
