Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,501
Single restaurant server	\$37,829 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$503
Teacher and office clerk family	\$60,426 and \$44,480 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$782
Single nurse with overtime	\$91,946 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,221
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,828 median local wage; 1 child	\$324
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,489 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,496 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,570 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$323
Police officer family	One earner at \$62,542 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$523

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$57,861 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$523
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$57,409 and \$28,828 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$801
