Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,573
Single restaurant server	\$50,183 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,102
Teacher and office clerk family	\$102,658 and \$55,197 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$859
Single nurse with overtime	\$122,021 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,492
Single-parent home health aide	\$48,066 median local wage; 1 child	\$443
Electrician family	One earner at \$104,600 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$683
Plumber family	One earner at \$89,668 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$395
Construction worker family	One earner at \$61,408 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$395
Police officer family	One earner at \$117,511 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$842

Firefighter family	One earner at \$105,089 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$883
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$71,303 and \$48,066 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$842
