Single restaurant server	\$29,907 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	Tax increase of \$18
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,086 and \$44,762 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$692
Single nurse with overtime	\$88,609 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,808
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,147 median local wage; 1 child	\$299
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,305 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$577
Plumber family	One earner at \$80,826 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$492
Construction worker family	One earner at \$53,513 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$390
