Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,497
Single restaurant server	\$27,202 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$8
Teacher and office clerk family	\$69,396 and \$48,152 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$829
Single nurse with overtime	\$101,181 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,946
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,919 median local wage; 1 child	\$299
Electrician family	One earner at \$93,563 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$492
Plumber family	One earner at \$96,247 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$492
Construction worker family	One earner at \$60,500 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$390
Police officer family	One earner at \$90,895 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$692

Firefighter family	One earner at \$44,972 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$519
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,421 and \$36,919 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$692

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
