Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,497
Single restaurant server	\$30,792 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$32
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,354 and \$44,134 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$692
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,467 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,784
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,901 median local wage; 1 child	\$299
Electrician family	One earner at \$79,086 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$577
Plumber family	One earner at \$84,501 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$492
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,055 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$390
Police officer family	One earner at \$94,374 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$692

Firefighter family	One earner at \$50,661 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$590
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,503 and \$33,901 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$692

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
