Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,497
Single restaurant server	\$26,459 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$34
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,720 and \$48,845 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$829
Single nurse with overtime	\$102,824 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,964
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,167 median local wage; 1 child	\$299
Electrician family	One earner at \$95,914 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$492
Plumber family	One earner at \$98,682 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$492
Construction worker family	One earner at \$61,676 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$390
Police officer family	One earner at \$96,476 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$692

Firefighter family	One earner at \$44,656 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$519
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,043 and \$37,167 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$692
