Single restaurant server	\$29,774 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	Tax increase of \$28
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,369 and \$45,172 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$692
Single nurse with overtime	\$82,465 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,134
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,525 median local wage; 1 child	\$299
Electrician family	One earner at \$72,462 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$577
Plumber family	One earner at \$86,518 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$492
Construction worker family	One earner at \$55,602 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$390
