Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,633
Single restaurant server	\$38,253 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$480
Teacher and office clerk family	\$76,074 and \$50,426 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$713
Single nurse with overtime	\$98,653 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,424
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,327 median local wage; 1 child	\$310
Electrician family	One earner at \$75,835 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$431
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,214 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$431
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,541 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$455
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,409 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$631

Firefighter family	One earner at \$67,676 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$631
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$58,205 and \$36,327 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$631
