Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,456
Single restaurant server	\$26,087 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$35
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,151 and \$43,455 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$715
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,202 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,099
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,203 median local wage; 1 child	\$289
Electrician family	One earner at \$75,616 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$337
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,293 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$340
Construction worker family	One earner at \$47,213 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$340
Police officer family	One earner at \$67,102 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$537

Firefighter family	One earner at \$53,379 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$540
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,048 and \$32,203 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$715
